LA INCIDENCIA DEL MORFEMA DE PRESENTE EN LA VARIACIÓN VERBAL

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ABSTRACT

In the Spanish verbal paradigm, only three verbs have a Present morpheme: the Present, the Present Perfect (in the auxiliar *have*) and the Perifrastic Future (in the construction *go to*). We are interested in these forms when they vary with: 1. the Present Perfect with the Preterite (*he ido/fui*); 2. the Perifrastic Future with the Simple Future (*voy a ir/iré*); 3. the Present in variation with prototypical past forms (*voy/fui*); and also 4. the Present in variation with prototypical future forms (*voy a ir/iré*). Based on the first results of our researches on type 1 variation (*he ido/fui*) our intention is go further in the explanation of the verbal paradigm in terms of Degrees of connection between the speaking sphere and the reference and the consequent impact on communication. For this reason, we focused on the analysis of 200 WhatsApp messages from speakers of Buenos Aires where we found the above mentioned cases.
